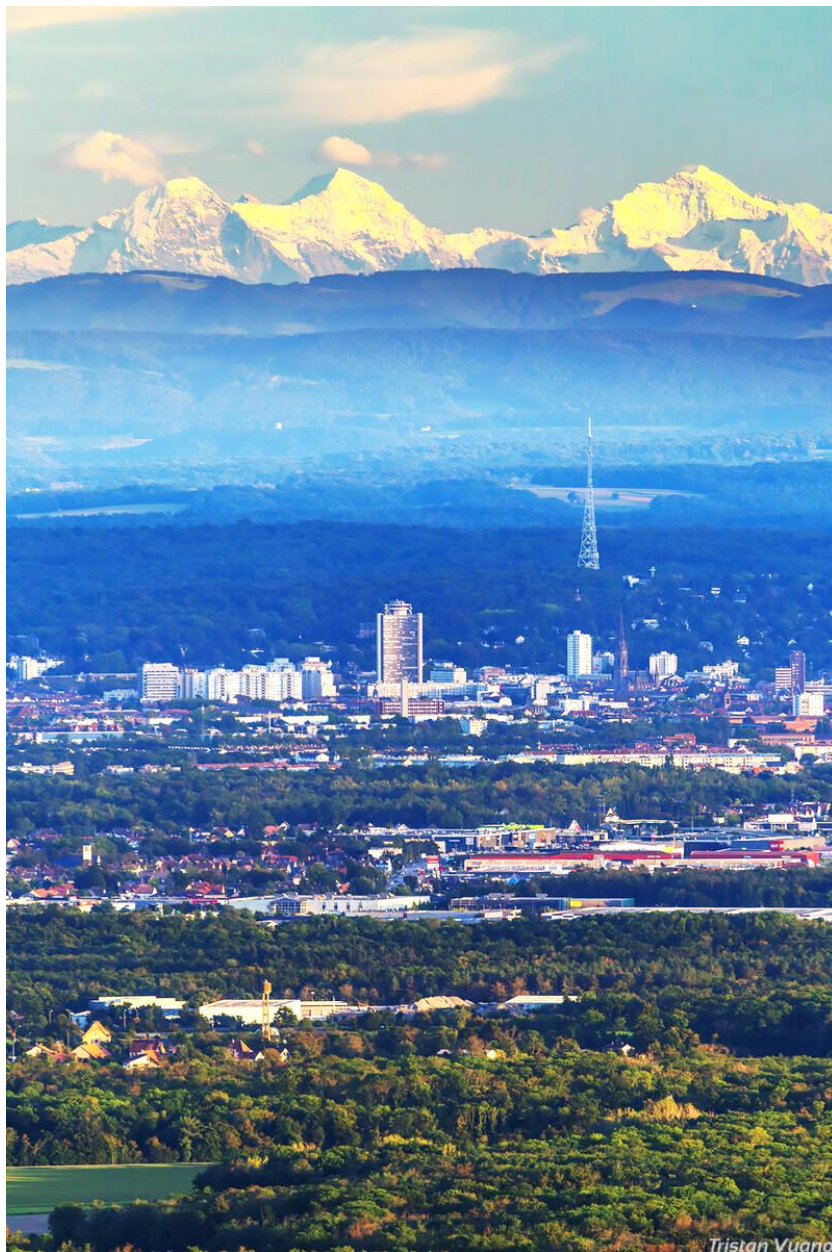

1. WELCOME IN MULHOUSE !

After months of preparation, we are pleased to welcome you to the beautiful city of **Mulhouse** the **Saturday 4th of October** for the Ariane Cross. But where is Mulhouse located ?



Figure 1 : Mulhouse ? Where is it ?

Mulhouse is located in the East of France and in the South of an amazing region called Alsace. It is a nice historical city of around 100'000 inhabitants amongst a "Communauté de Communes" of 39 cities gathering more than 280'000 inhabitants.

It is close to Strasbourg (115 km), Freiburg-In-Breisgau in Germany (60 km) and Basel in Switzerland (40 km).



The Alsace region is world widely known for its lively white wines like Riesling, Sylvaner, Gewürstraminer or Pinot but also for its gastronomy based on light 😊 meals like Choucroute or Flammekueche also known as Tarte Flambée.



2. THE EVENT

The Ariane Cross has been an international event for decades, gathering hundreds of runners from all over Europe. The common denominator of all these fans of running is that they all belong, directly or indirectly, to the industrial community / companies which participate in the European Ariane launcher space program.

Last year, we had the pleasure of being hosted by the city of Sevilla in Spain, the year before, it was Vernon in France, etc...

Just to say that the challenge is exciting for Mulhouse!!

This year, the event will attract around 500 participants, amongst 25 teams, male and female, small or tall, beginner or high graded runners!

Over the years, a format has been found: the event will start Friday 3rd of October evening with the teams captains' meeting, continue with the running events on Saturday 4th of October morning, a big picnic on Saturday lunchtime, tourist visits on Saturday afternoon and a gala evening on Saturday night.

The event concludes on Saturday evening after the gala evening, with teams departing on Sunday.

3. THE ENVIRONMENT

The races will be located at the meeting point of a modern and up-to-date city and a green and relaxing area.

They will take place in "La plaine Sportive de l'III" in Mulhouse:

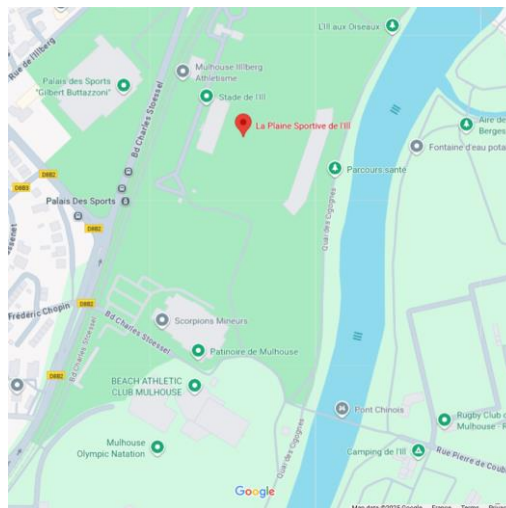


Figure 2 : La plaine Sportive de l'III map

La Plaine Sportive de l'III gathers world class sports facilities, including an international football stadium called "Stade de l'III", headquarter of the "Football Club de Mulhouse", an impressive "Palais des Sports", where the national women's "Volley Mulhouse Alsace" has its headquarters and an Olympic sized swimming complex called "Mulhouse Olympic Natation" where all the best French and international swimmers are training all year long.

All these sports facilities are enshrined in a marvelous green wooden area which encourages all the best sports performances.

4. THE RACES

Four distances are proposed

- 2'500 m
- 5'000 m
- 10'000 m
- A 6'000 m relay split into 4 legs of 1'500 m each.

As this is a cross-country race, there may be some minor difficulties with gradients. The 2'500 m and the relay courses are fast.

Only runners who have taken part in one of the individual races may take part in the relay.

All the races will take place at the "Stade de l'III".

4.1. THE 2'500 M RACE

The shortest race consists in departing at the "Stade de l'III" stadium and finishing at the same location within this stadium on what we call the Basic circuit.

4.2. THE 5'000 M RACE

The 5'000 m race will consist of the same circuit but running it two times.

4.3. THE 10'000 M RACE

And the 10'000 m race is also the same circuit, but ... four times.

4.4. THE RELAY

The relay is a different circuit. The 4 runners will browse a specific circuit on the same location, each of them running 1'500 m in full speed.

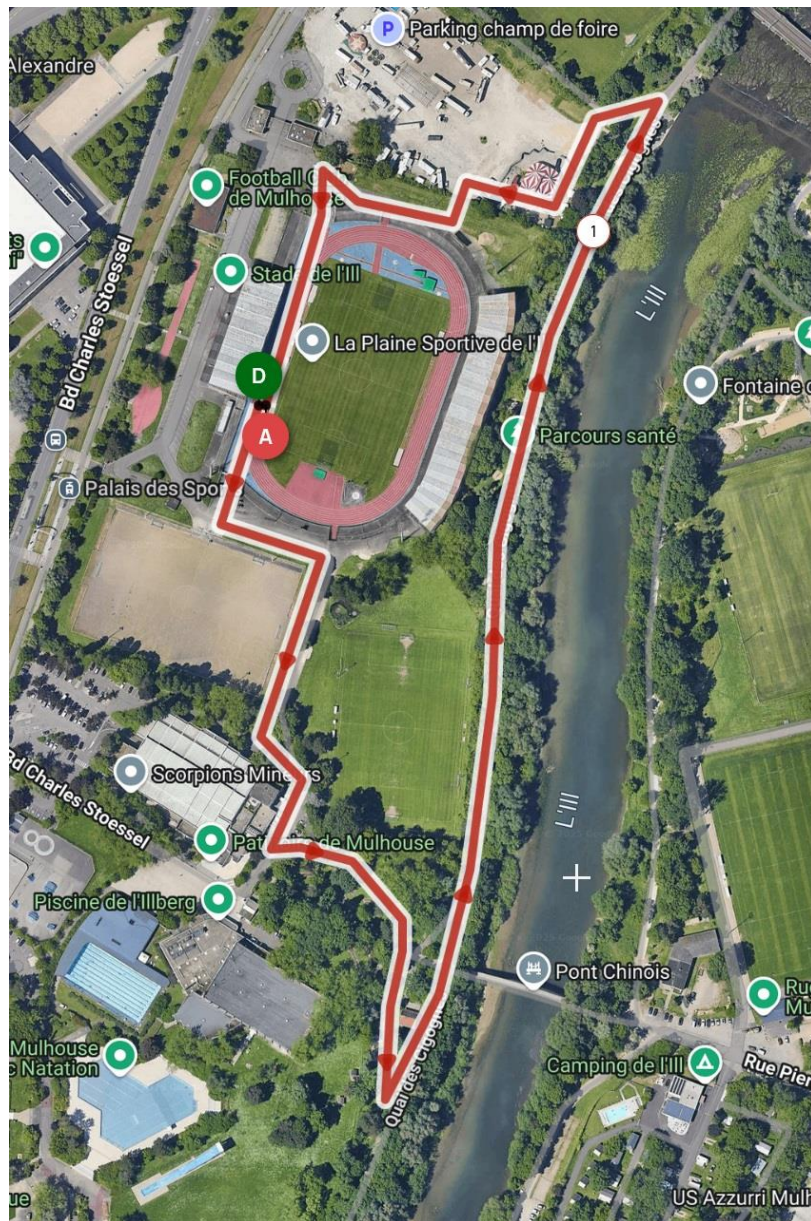


Figure 4 : The relay circuit

5. THE AGENDA OF THE EVENT

The overall agenda of the event will gather instructions on Friday, sports on Saturday morning, pleasure and discovery on Saturday afternoon, congratulation and fun on Saturday evening and end on Sunday.

5.1. FRIDAY

The teams Captains are invited to a briefing meeting at 19:00 at '**Le Palais des Sports**' – 16, Bld Charles Stoessel – Mulhouse close to the stadium 'Stade de l'Ill' (around 20min from city center by public transportation Tram Line 2 Direction Coteaux, departure station: Porte Jeune, arrival station: Palais des Sports)

The briefing meeting will elaborate on:

- The detailed program of the event, with a clear reminder of cut-off times.
- Transportation and meeting points.
- Races routes, indicating any difficulties
- Venues: races, visits, evening events.
- Useful maps
- Useful phone numbers and Whatsapp group (see section 6)
- Free public transportation coupon for every team member (validity starting at first usage in public transportation (Tram or Tram Train) for a period of 24 hours).

Once the briefing is over, it is time for the delivery of race numbers and event T-shirts and have an aperitif all together.

⇒ IMPORTANT: please allow time and material for last-minute distance changes.

And last but not least: handing out of a bag with goodies representative of the organizing company and the host city.

5.2. SATURDAY MORNING

Arrival of runners between 60- and 30-minutes prior the chosen race at 'Stade de l'III'.

Two paths are foreseen: One via the stadium, one via the street in front of the stadium.

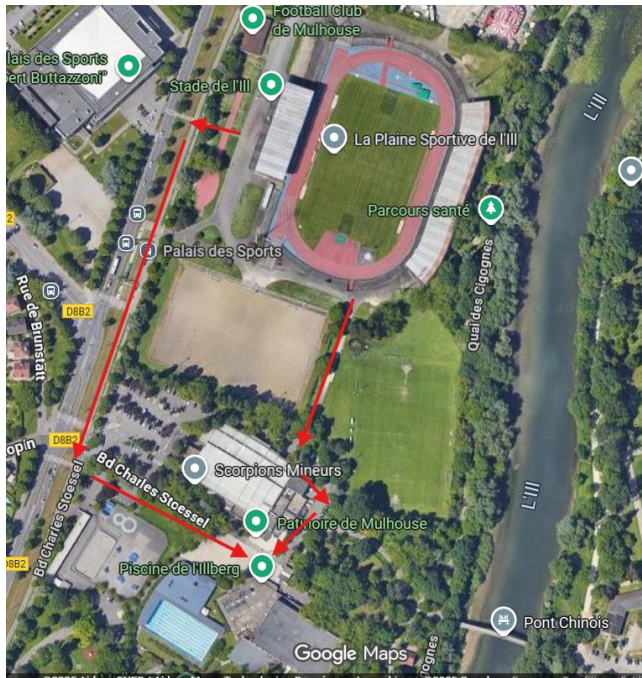


Figure 5 : Access to the showers

7. PHOTOGRAPHS / VIDEOS

Professional photographer and video will be on place to capture images of the event. These pictures and video will be shown on a large screen during the Gala dinner.

Everyone can take pictures, and the captains are invited to share the best ones on the Whatsapp group of the event (max 10 pictures per captain).

We base our policy on free and open General Data Protection Regulation rules as mentioned in Article 17 of our general rules (see section 8, article 17).

8. RULES

Article 1 – Organization

M2A, Eiffage Energie Systèmes and the Comité Ariane Cross, are organizing the 46th ARIANE CROSS competition on 04th October in Mulhouse, France

Article 2 – Races

The ARIANE CROSS meeting includes both individual races and a 4 X 1.500 m.

Three optional distances are offered for the individual races: 2.500 m, 5.000 m and 10.000 m.

Note: All distances are indications only.

Article 3 – Participants

The event is opened to employees from European companies engaged in the European launchers programs, as well as the employees' partners.

Article 4 – Closing date

The entry deadline (individual events and relay) as the final date for applications to participate in ARIANE CROSS 2025 is 30th June 2025.

Article 5 – Team

Team captain

Each team must appoint a captain who will be the contact point with the organizers.

Company Team composition

Except for the organization team, each team shall be composed of participants up to 70 runners.

Article 6 – Medical Certification

In accordance with the recommendations of the French Athletics Federation and Law No. 2022-296 of March 2, 2022, a medical certificate is not required any more.

Nevertheless, each team captain will check that all runners in his team have health conditions to practice running in competition.

The Organizing Committee cannot be held responsible for any medical issues.

Article 7 – Age categories (individual races)

Age categories for this cross-country event are only defined with the year of birth. The following categories have

been defined:

WOMEN'S CATEGORIES

RACE	2007-1986*	1976-1985*	1975* and before

5'000 m	B1	B2	B3
10'000 m	C1	C2	C3

MEN'S CATEGORIES

Article 8 – Individual race

A competitor can enter only one individual race.

Article 9 – Relay race

A relay team consists of 4 runners from a team who have all participated in an individual race.

The relay team must be composed as follows :

Relay	Runner1	Runner2	Runner3	Runner4
Gender	Female	Male	Female	Male
Birth Date	2007-1986*	2007-1986*	1985* and before	1985* and before

Any relay team not respecting the above-mentioned composition, shall not be allowed to participate the relay race. A relay competitor can enter only one relay team.

Article 10– Team points from individual races

The ranking will be established upon order of arrival of 4 Runners and not depending on the time/chrono.

For each individual race (2.500 m, 5.000 m and 10.000 m), two overall rankings will be established:

- A women's overall ranking, all categories
- A men's overall ranking, all categories.

In each women's race, the following will be recorded:

- The best performance within the team, regardless of age category.

The points allocated correspond to the place obtained in the women's overall ranking.

Thus, over 5.000 m for example, a team whose best athlete was 3rd (overall) will be allocated 3 points.

In each men's race, the following will be recorded:

- The best performance among runners born in 1986 and after,

- The best performance among runners born in 1985 and before.

The points allocated correspond to the sum of the two places obtained in the men's overall ranking.

Example: over 2.500 m, a team whose best athlete born in 1986 or after finishes 8th (overall) and whose best athlete born in 1985 or before finishes 15th (overall) will receive $8 + 15 = 23$ points.

Any team that does not have a representative in a given race, will be allocated the number of points scored by the lowest scoring athlete overall (women and men) plus 1.

Example: in the 10.000 m women's race for example, if 25 female athletes finish, teams that have no representatives in that race will be allocated 26 points.

The total individual point score of a team is therefore equal to the sum of points scored by its best representatives (women whatever the birth year + men born in 1986 and after + men born in 1985 and before in each race).

This total score is then divided by 9, giving the average of individual points scored for the team.

Article 11 – Team points from relay race

The ranking will be established upon order of arrival of 4 Runners and not depending on the time/chrono. It is understood that only the best relay team of the team companies is taken into account for the establishment of the final ranking.

In the relay race the following will be recorded:

The best performance of a relay team within the team.

The number of points scored by a given team in a relay race corresponds to the best team's relay team finishing place (1 point for the relay team finishing first ...).

A team that does not finish the relay race will be allocated the number of points awarded to the team finishing last, plus 1.

Note: Teams are allowed to participate in the relay race with multiple teams.

Article 12 – Final ranking

The final ranking is obtained by adding the number of points scored in the relay race to the average of the individual points scored by the team.

The ranking is established by the representatives of the Ariane Cross Committee.

13 – Trophies

The first three finishers in each category will be awarded a trophy.

The first three teams in the relay will be awarded a trophy.

The final team ranking shall be announced during the trophy awards ceremony.

The Ariane Cross challenge cup will be awarded to the team that finishes in first place.

This cup is put back in competition at each edition.

Article 14 – Timings

The schedules below are given for informational purposes; they may be changed if necessary.

The individual races will start at the following times:

- 10.000 m, categories C1 to C6: start 09.00 am
- 5.000 m, categories B1 to B6: start 10.30 am
- 2.500 m, categories A1 to A6 start 11.30 am

The relay race will start at 12:00 am.

Competitors are to assemble at the start line 10 minutes before the published start of each event.

Article 15 – General arrangements

Numbers must be worn on the chest. The use of spiked shoes is not allowed. Failure to respect the rules or directions given by an official or route marshal may result in disqualification.

Article 16

All participants agree to abide by these rules; failure to do so may result in disqualification.

Article 17

All participants agree that photos, video material, and interviews made in connection with his/her participation in the event can be broadcasted and published on TV, the internet, radios, in printed material, books, photo copies (video footage, video tapes, etc.) without fees. Moreover, participants agree that personal data, such as name, year of birth and company can be provided in starting lists and results.

9. END OF GALA DINNER BUS ROTATION

At the end of the Gala dinner, 6 bus rotations are organized from midnight to 02:10 (00h00, 00h30, 00h50, 01:20, 01:40, 02:10) starting from 'La Cité du Train' and bringing all the Gala evening participants back to their hotels.

The buses are well dimensioned, but of course, please do not focus only on the last bus and anticipate your back trip.
